IN BRASILIA, THE CONFERENCE IS PRESENTED TO STRATEGIC AUDIENCES

At the event, which brought together around 150 people, mining representatives spoke about sustainable practices in the sector and reaffirmed their commitment to sustainable socioeconomic development for the Amazon region. The presentation of The Amazon and New Economies International Conference (Belém, from August 30th to September 1st) for government representatives, industry leaders, parliamentarians, ambassadors and journalists, took place on Wednesday, July 12th, at the headquarters of the Brazilian Mining Institute (IBRAM), in Brasília (DF).



The president of IBRAM, Raul Jungmann, highlighted that "the Amazon is at the heart of the issue of the climate crisis and how to overcome it. For this reason, the Brazilian mineral sector decided to embrace the Amazon. Embracing the Amazon means that we want to preserve, yes, but also to develop the Amazon". The Secretary for the Environment and Sustainability of the state of Pará, Mauro O'de Almeida, spoke about the expectation on the results of the event. From the discussions, led by IBRAM, we will have good content to apply in public policies".



For former Environment Minister Izabella Teixeira, "Brazil is a candidate country for solutions to its development process. And, more than that, solutions to deal with the eradication of hunger and inequality in that country". The director of Institutional Relations at Vale, Luiz Ricardo Santiago and the senior manager of Institutional Relations at Hydro, Paula Marlieri, also addressed those present.
